DEVELOPMENT PROJECT NEGOTIATED PROGRAMMING:

"Territorial Pact in Bucharest"

Abstract. Programming negotiated in Italy, is a programming methodology that adjusts interventions of a variety of public and private, depending on the management unit of resources. The Territorial Pact, since the typical negotiated planning is proposed by the Association of Small and Medium Enterprise Campania, in order to achieve a process of local development, involving the city of Bucharest.

Definition and purpose. The Territorial Pact of Bucharest "should be the expression of social partnership and, therefore, aimed at local development. The proposal of the Association of Small and Medium Enterprises- PMI CAMPANIA, given the signature of specific memoranda of understanding, with similar associations in Romania, as well as agreed during the meetings between the Delegation of the Association appointed Italian Authorities and the Government of Romania and other institutional actors, in the days 30 and March 31 ca, as shown in the official record attached, is to want activate in the Province of Bucharest, a program of integrated interventions in the sectors industry, agriculture, services and infrastructure of the. The objectives the "Territorial Pact of Bucharest" is therefore the promotion of local development in sub-eco-sustainable, self-sustainable and for further action. In other geographical areas of Romania, because it is capable of activating resources immediately financial, in precisely those areas "disadvantaged" and as such, more needy.

Proposing. The "Territorial Pact of Bucharest" is supported by Italian Small and Medium Enterprise- "PMI CAMPANIA" with the authority of the Government Romania, namely:

1. Ministry of Small and Medium Enterprises, in the person of Mrs Mary Parcalabescu - Secretary of State of P.M.I.;
- 2nd NATIONAL COUNCIL SME President Corneliu Tanase;
- 3rd UCCIBR Union Chamber of Commerce and Industry bilaterally, President Jose Iacobescu;
- 4th CCIPR-Camera di Commercio Italo-Romanian, Chairman;
- 5th All other competent institutions and operating on the territory of reference;
6. The local authorities in Bucharest, the representations of local entrepreneurs and workers and private parties. Obviously those who primarily promotes. And: the Region or autonomous province which lies in the pact, the banks or companies they controlled, consortia credit guarantee groups and consortia of industrial development over trade unions.

Subjects underwriters. Obviously, the subjects first proponents, and the banks or companies they control, consortia guarantee groups and consortia development industry, if any.

Commitments for the underwriters of the Territorial Pact. Who should sign the "Pact Land in Bucharest ", assumes the responsibility to respect the commitments and obligations arising from signing the pact. Therefore:

1. The Ministry of Small and Medium Enterprises together with the Ministry of the Economy Government of Romania, include the "Territorial Pact of Bucharest, between actions and implementing initiatives of regional programs, including those of Community;

2nd Banks and regional financial, within the limits of their statutes, have the commitment to funding support for productive activities, not covered by their own resources or from public funding;

3rd Consortia of collective guarantee, assume the commitment to guarantee loans banks;

4th The bodies of local government and other government authorities, are committed to implement those rules that allow the simplification and acceleration of procedures.

Identification of the subject Head of Territorial Pact. The Public signatories of the pact identify, including through the establishment of a separate body mixed between the respective representatives of Associations of Small Businesses in Romania and PMI-CAMPANIA and Local Government, the Head of the coordination and implementation of "Territorial Pact of Bucharest." Subject Head of the "Territorial Pact Bucarest, represents a uniform interest of underwriters.

The obligations of the Head of the Territorial Pact. Subject Head of the "Covenant land in Bucharest", will perform several functions, including:

➤ Enable the financial resources for the anticipation and / or the cofinancing

state, regional and community, including promoting the use of the grant

overall, as well as organizational and technical resources required for implementation of the Covenant Planning;

➤ Ensure the preparation and publication of public notices, which contain criteria and modalities for the disbursement of public funds, including those of the Structural Funds, in different areas of interest of Italian-Romanian, specially formed (cf. Memoranda of Understanding);

➤ Verify compliance with commitments and obligations of the underwriters, promoting the necessary actions in case of failures or delays, and coherence of the new initiatives with development objectives in the pact is finalized Territorial Pact;

➤ Ensure the monitoring and verification of results;

➤ To promote all appropriate action, if necessary, to prevent possible delays, including conferences services.

The Head of the Territorial Pact, take care to present to the Ministry of Economy and to the Small and Medium Enterprises in Romania and to the local competent authority, a half-yearly report on the implementation of the Territorial Pact, highlighting results, monitoring and verification activities carried out, should also provide explanations on projects not activated or no longer provided for, with the resulting statement availability of unused resources, be able to allocate more investment.

The contents of the Territorial Pact. The territorial agreement must contain the financial plan, with commitments of expenditure on each intervention to be carried out, indicating the timing and contributions and public funding required from the specific resources intended by the Government of Romania. The pact also will include an agreement between the Public actors involved. Finally, to achieve the strengthening of the conditions of security, the "Territorial Pact of Bucharest, will be accompanied with specific protocols agreement with the bodies responsible for the protection of order and public security, without any financial burden of employers and members.

Articulation Agreement between the Public. In line with the provisions of the program under the Public Subject define the obligations of responsible, related to the implementation and development of investment, any exceptions to the rules routine administrative and accounting, for acceleration and simplification proceedings. Administrations involved can determine variations of the instruments urban and replacement of permits and / or building permits.

The finance of the Territorial Pact. The "Territorial Pact of Bucharest", will provide the use of special facilities for the Romanian Government (Ministry of Small and Medium Enterprise and the Ministry of Economy), in relation to development initiatives planned. When satisfied that the availability of governmental administrations, the "Territorial Pact" mobilize additional resources at Community, regional and local levels. Infrastructure, besides being functional to the aims and objectives of the Territorial Pact, not should exceed 30% of resources allocated to investment. The share of own resources made available by individuals, not be below 30%.

The requirements for operation of the Territorial Pact. The requirements to guarantee the implementation of "Territorial Pact of Bucharest", are:

- The existence of concertation between the social partners, as above;
- The consistency of the proposal with the objectives of local development;
- The subscription of a specific act of understanding-operation between the social partners;
- The availability of investment projects to business initiatives that can also to foster regional cooperation programs north-south.

Disbursements. Subject Head of the Territorial Pact, transmit to the competent Bank adopted, the list of planned operations, indicating the resources needed, to apply the specific amounts allocated by the Romanian government to the "Territorial Pact Bucharest", along with the final report of their inquiry. The Bank responsible, with the possible delay in order to avoid any interruption in implementing the program of investment and, in any event within 20 days of receipt documentation provides for the payment of amounts due to holders of the draft investment.

The role of the Ministry of Budget and Economic Planning of the establishment of the "Territorial Pact". The offices of the Ministry of Economy, at the request of the Responsible Subject Territorial Pact, can help to define the useful documentation requirements, the Ministry of Economy will provide, including through convention services company, supports to help ensure the practical and operational in the preparatory phase.

Later, once completed the consultation between the Parties industry, established the existence of the requirements and obtained the opinion of the Ministry of Small and Medium Enterprises in Romania, within 30 days approving the pact, with the enactment of specific measure. Within the next 60 days of the date of said decision Ministerial, should be concluded the "Territorial Pact of Bucharest."
